III. Duncan. (Amelia has Duncan VIII the son of Gregor VII, and so does Inverhadden)  
 m Catherine d of Duncan Campbell of Glenlyon. (Amelia has prev wife of C of GL').  
 Inverhadden says Duncan married a daughter of Robertson of Faschoille in Athole. It appears  
 that she was first married to Stewart of Appin to whom she had a son and heir, 2ndly to  
 to Campbell of Glenlyon to whom she had a son and heir, and lastly to McGregor of Roro to  
 whom she had two sons 1. Gregor, 2. John dubb. However GSI has her married to Gregor, not  
 Duncan. The records at this point become very confused and contradictory.

-- Alexander +1745. s.p.m. GSI has him k at battle of Inverlochry 2Feb1645.

--IX. Gregor. m sister of James Menzies of Culdares, and succeeded to that estate  
 Accompanied the first Lord Breadalbane in the expedition against the Sinclairs. Paid to  
 Commissioner John Campbell of Glendarual 25Apr1673 for Mains of Roro. Referred to in Buchanan  
 papers

--X. Gregor, alias John Gordon. m d of Robertson of Tullybellirn (Tullibelton). Burdened his  
 estate considerably in the '15. Made a deed in favour of his only son: 33

--XI. Duncan. m Isabella Foster. Joined Price Charles in the '45, but which he was so  
 reduced he had to work as a clerk in Perth for his uncle Tullibelton. Before leaving  
 the country he borrowed on the deeds of Roro from his friend John McGregor at  
 Lagfearn, who made the fatal mistake of showing the deeds to Campbell of Achallader  
 factor to the Earl of Breadalbane.

--Gregor. Sailed for India in HMS Captain June 12 1744, Spithead, and was  
 not heard of again.

--Alexander. H.E.I.C.S. Not heard of after Oct 26 1754.  
 --Christina +unnm.  
 --Catherine +1809. m Donald McAndrew at Tynaline to whom she had several  
 children: she d at Perth 4 June 1809 aged 88, and that was the end of that family.

--Duncan Roy, m d of Baron McDairmid, Craignevie, Glenlyon.

--John, d in England without issue. However: "The master of MacGregor's Hotel was  
 Shemis Mac Eoin vic Dhonacha ruaidh vic Gregor which Gregor was laird of Ruadh Struth."  
 (PD60/50. Cent. Reg. Arch. - ie James son of John of Duncan Roy of Gregor - JCW).

--Hugh Roy, m(1) Christian McGregor from Roro by whom | sons and 1 daur, all dsp.  
 m(2) Catharine (Christian-GSI) Lothian by whom: (Inverhadden)

--Donald, a schoolmaster at Inverarra, m(1) Margaret McIntyre, sister to the Rev Dr  
 McIntyre minister of Glenorchy. m(2) Janet McDonald in Glenlyon. He d 1821.  
 By his first wife:  
 --a daur, m Alexander McCallum, excise officer.  
 By his second wife:  
 --James, who succeeded his uncle to the estate of Fonab, and is now (1843) surgeon  
 surgeon to the Royal 42nd Regt and unmarried.

--Hugh (Eoghann Mor died 1880.  
 --a son Charles, who lately (pre 1841) had the Banavie Hotel (GSI)  
 --Margaret, m Dr McIntyre, Fortingall.  
 --a son, pre 1841 residing in Australia or NZ, the then laird of Fonab.  
 --daur to Jas McLaren, Dunan.  
 --daur to Alex McCallum, Inverarra.  
 --daur unmarried 1843. So ends the House of Roro according to Inverhadden.

--John, who lived at Monzie.

--James, m Janet McKay of Clyth, Caithness but no issue. He long kept an hotel on  
 Princess St Edinburgh, retiring to the estate of Fonab in Athole, 1819, d 17Feb1837.

 --Donald, of whom little is known. Is this the father of Lt Evan?
